ASYLUM SEEKER ADVOCACY PROJECT



This collaborative, non-partisan organization assist families from Central American, Syria, Eritrea, Brazil and Venezuela. These families are fleeing life threatening and sexual violence, including repeated beatings and rape. These people are also suffering from extreme trauma as survivors of torture and witnesses to the murder of family and friends.

Please save your coins and give generously to this organization that has helped so many families win their legal battles in order to attain a lasting hope of protecting and welcoming our brothers and sisters, because we are all interconnected through God. The defense of human rights and dignity is what we wish for ourselves and all of our loved ones.

This organization provides rapid pro bono legal representation at a distance, reaching families who could not otherwise access legal services in the United States.
