

# Capital Campaign Update

Thank you everyone for your financial commitments, prayers, volunteerism and support of all kinds. We are excited to let you know that the capital campaign has produced significant giving towards the Phase 1 & Phase 2 projects. At this time, we are short of being able to accomplish both projects simultaneously in spite of the Building Committee working very hard to do all they could to possibly make it work.

After many thoughtful conversations about Phase 1 & Phase 2, the Capital Campaign General Chairpersons, the Building Committee and the Capital Campaign Auditor and Finance & Stewardship Chair all agree to take the course of fiscal responsibility as well as smart construction management and focus on just the Phase 1 + Infrastructure improvements. We will be proposing to not pursue the Youth Center at this time, but to put our time, money & efforts solely into this Phase 1 + Infrastructure project. The Youth Center will require a new and separate Phase 2 Capital Campaign at a later time.

The Administrative Council endorsed the delaying of the Youth Center and to pursue Phase 1 + Infrastructure.

The donors of the generous Youth Center challenge gifts have offered to reallocate their donations to the Phase 1 + Infrastructure project and the Youth Pastor Fund. This selfless gesture secures our ability to do the Phase 1 + Infrastructure project and pursue hiring a full time Youth Pastor.

Please come to Worship on Sunday, May 18th to participate in the Congregational vote to accept the Administrative Council's recommendation of Phase 1 + Infrastructure. The vote will be held after the second service at approximately 11:30 a.m.
