Charge Conference Vote Results

The Building Team and Capital Campaign Team are pleased to announce the results of Sunday, May 18 Charge Conference vote. Tim Fingeroos, Trustees Chairperson, presided over the vote count and reported that the building and funding proposals were approved by an 89% majority.

We anticipate signing a loan application with the Wisconsin United Methodist Foundation in the coming weeks. It is expected to be for an approved amount of \$700,000 with a 5-year rate lock at 4%, a term of 15 years, amortized over 20 years. Additionally, we will

be seeking approval from the City of Cedarburg in June. We anticipate starting construction in early August.

We wish to thank everyone who took time to attend the Charge Conference and cast your vote as our church begins this next stage of our building project. We also extend our gratitude for everyone's useful input, wisdom and certainly their generous financial support of the building project.
