
Pastor Dave On Vacation — Pastor Dave will be on vacation from July 4th through July 14th.

Beginning Wednesday, July 16, Pastor Dave will lead a new mid-week summer worship called, "People of the Book". In past summers, we have had "Vespers," a Eucharistic service. We have also had "Wonderful Wednesdays of Worship," special musically based services. This summer, we will try our hand at a new style of abbreviated worship: "People of the Book." As with past



The jokes number in the hundreds, but they are all variations on one theme. "How many seasons are there in Wisconsin? Two – winter and road repair." In many ways, we all dread seeing those orange signs indicating some form of construction. On the other hand, we can hardly wait for what is the end result.
