Easter Offering — Easter Offering goes to missionary Paul Webster (#11865Z) at Mujila Falls Agriculture Centre in Zambia. Find his Facebook page www.facebook.com/Mujlafallsagcentre so you can see the photos too. **Feb. 9, 2015** - *"Friday we successfully delivered 1,200 layer chicks and 500 broiler chicks to the site. This took a two day trip to Kitwe and two days back. We lost only 13 chicks on the trip. We should have broiler chickens for sale in just 6 weeks and egg layers in just 18 to 20 weeks."* **March 5, 2015** - *"Those Broiler Chicks are only three weeks old and should be ready for sale in two and a half more weeks. We have had very low mortality and very good growth. They will help add a lot of protein to the local diets."*

Northcott Missionary To Speak — Northcott Neighborhood House UMC Global Mission Fellow, Tyler Smoot, will be joining us Sunday, April 12. The Global Mission Fellows program takes young adults ages 20-30 out of their home environments and places them in new contexts for two years of mission service. Tyler is serving at Northcott in their GED program. He holds a Bachelor of Arts degree in religion and psychology from Baylor University, Waco, Texas, and a Master of Divinity degree from Duke University Divinity School, Durham, North Carolina. Tyler will be giving the message and sharing a little about his experience at Northcott and how we can be in mission together.
