In this isolated and rural distressed area with chronic poverty, poor housing, lack of jobs Red Bird strives to meet the needs of the residents through ministry in five areas: Education, Health and Wellness, Community Outreach, Economic Opportunity, and Community Housing Improvement. The education ministries provides a Cristian education for grades K-12 and early childhood development. Health and welfare provides medical and dental services. The other ministries provide a variety of services to families, older adults, women and children, and youth to make their lives fuller and more livable. Our church has had mission trips to Red Bird and can attest to the needs in the area and the positive work Red Bird is doing. Coins will be collected in the offering plate and can also be dropped in the designated jar in the office. The second quarter is April, May, and June. Thank you for your support!
