6. Deliver food to Agape Community Center (42nd & Kaul, Milwaukee) by 4:30 p.m.
7. Assemble desserts, salads, prepare food for serving at 5:30 p.m.
8. Help with cleanup. We are usually back in Cedarburg at 7:00 p.m.
