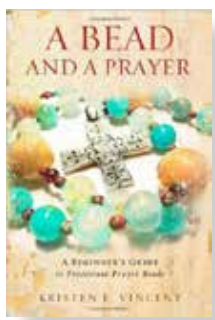

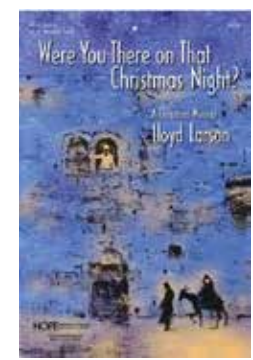
## Prayer Beads Workshop

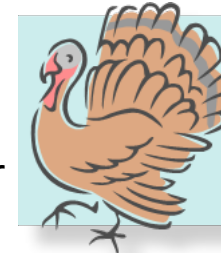
