Northcott Neighborhood Youth Ministry — We are launching a new Ministry to serve “at risk” youths who are working to get their GEDs completed at Northcott. Under the leadership of Tyler Smoot (Tyler spoke at our church this year and he is a Global Mission Fellow of the United Methodist General Board of Global Ministries) and CUMC member Debbie Harder, a small group of volunteers will be serving lunch and hosting a Bible study on Thursdays at 11:30

am beginning January 14 and ending May 12th or 26th. We are looking for volunteers to cook and serve a meal for the youth, some of which are on the bracelet and many which have been in trouble with the law. These young men are between 15 and 18 years old. In the morning they work toward their GED and in the afternoon they help build a house which is later sold.
