February Food Collection — Our February food collection will serve our Milwaukee neighbors in the area of 6th and Wright. Let's have a great showing of our concern and care for the people who depend on Northcott, a UM agency, for some of the very basic needs of life. If each family sets a goal of providing one food item a week, we would have a huge amount of food to deliver. Let's just do it!

One Great Hour of Sharing — We can truly make a world of difference on March 6. This offering supplies the administrative costs for our great mission agency, UMCOR. United Methodist Committee on Relief works in disaster response, humanitarian aid, global health, and refugee and immigration programs. UMCOR is present in 80 countries, including the US. Only 10% of UMCOR's total funding can be used for administration, so any money given over 10% is used in programs. Because administrative

costs are covered, all money given to an UMCOR program goes to that specific designation. Let's be generous March 6!
