Cash Donations for Diaper Drive — Nationwide, the high cost of diapers stresses the budgets of many lowincome families. CUMC has partnered with Jet.com to purchase high quality, cost effective Cuties diapers. This is a limited, special program they offer to non-profit organizations. Cuties Economy Plus Packs will be purchased at a price of \$.13 - .17 (compared to an average price of \$.30-50). This is how it works: Make a donation at the "coin box" in Fellowship Hall, or put money in offering plate with Sojourner or Diaper drive in memo line in June, July and August. Coin drive donations for the rest of the quarter will also go towards the Diaper drive. Funds are pooled together and we purchase the diapers in bulk from Jet. The diapers arrive here at CUMC in September and will be delivered to Sojourner Truth Peace House, for their families in need. Thanks for your generous participation!
