Two Honor Flight Veterans Pioneer Drum & Bugle Corps

Joe Demler is a 90-year-old World War II Army veteran from Port Washington who was captured at the Battle of the Bulge in Europe. As a POW in a Nazi prison camp, he was depicted by Life magazine as "The Human Skeleton." He is interviewed in worship by Pastor Dave.
