The Men's Study Group has picked up another book to read and discuss. Next week we will begin our look at "Lost Christianities: The battles for Scripture and the Faiths We Never Knew." The author, Bart Ehrman, reviews the early forms of Christianity and shows how they came to be reformed, forgotten, or even suppressed.

The early Christian groups that were spread throughout the Mediterranean basin each insisted they had the true teachings of Jesus and his apostles; moreover they had writings and other documentation that supported their

claims. Subsequent archaeological findings have recovered their antiquities which reveal a religious diversity that has led to our current approach to Christianity written by the winners.
