July 28 "Foundry is a famed historic UMC congregation of strident influence and advocacy in the heart of D.C. not very far from the White House. Known for scholarship, oratory, mission, social justice, ethics, and reconciliation ministries ... they've served D.C. (including many UM politicians; the Clintons having attended here regularly, Hillary with strong UM roots) leveraging a prominent voice.
