### Mini-Retreat & Discussion of Gear Up!

— Sunday, May 19 from 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. Several of our committees and small groups have been reading a book that describes processes in local congregations that support revitalization, growth, and new ministry development: *Gear Up! Nine Essential Processes for the Optimized Church* (by Kay Kotan). Concepts in this book have been included in the recent sermon series using another one of Kay's books, based on research, consultations and learning from the Healthy Church Initiative (HCI). We have a Sunday School class starting at this time that will also look at this resource (Pat Morrissey's class), and Nate is expanding this conversation into youth ministry too.

The Administrative Council has scheduled a mini-retreat to discuss *Gear Up!* and identify the process steps or "gears" for future focus and priority at CUMC. All who have been reading or studying this book, or who are interested in becoming part of the conversation, are welcome to attend. *Nourishment and child-care will be provided.*

The "gears" we will be thinking about include:

1. Relationship-Building Process
2. Hospitality Process
3. Connection Process
4. Intentional Faith-Development Process
5. Worship Design Process
6. People Development Process
7. Simplification with Accountability Process
8. Strategic Planning and Evaluation Process
9. Congregational Care Process
