It's Christmas Eve. When planning worship, sometimes we think we've got to do something new, got to come up with a different way of telling this story. How can we repackage this text, this message, this theme so that it will break through the ears and hearts of the worshipers? But it is not necessary toniaht. See, the new thing has been done. Tonight is about the tradition, about the familiar, about feeling at home in this space. Even if you are here for the first time. there is a familiarity to this night. It speaks to something deep within us, a yearning, a longing, a hunger. Sing the songs you always sing. Tell the story you always tell. Light the candles and hold them up as you sing "Silent Night," just like you did when you were a kid. Just like that.
